THE MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Residents of Brackley,

It is a great honour to be Mayor of the Town and to represent you all at events over the County and our neighbouring Counties.

It was lovely to meet some of you at the D-DAY 80 Commemoration and Beacon Lighting. It was a very poignant evening and an honour to be in my robes for the Ceremony and to assist with the lighting of the Beacon at 21.15 – the time that across the country, all the beacons were lit.

Last time I was Mayor, Brackley commemorated WW1 and WW2 and some of the roads on Radstone Fields Estate are named after the beaches where the troops landed on D-Day - Juno, Gold, Sword, Omaha and Utah and of course Poppyfields Way for remembrance. All were named by Brackley Town Council. In Egerton Hall we have a display of poppies that came from the Tower of London Display in 2014. The number of poppies is equal to the number of names on the War Memorial.

I hope to see you all at the events being organised this summer in August. We have the Teddy Bears Festival on the 14th and on the 18th a very special Classic Cars in the Park as it is the 10th Anniversary of the event that has been run by the Classic Car Club. Moving forward, this event will now be run jointly with Brackley Town Council. Each year since 2014, the donations collected have been for the Mayors' Charities which has given a good boost to funds raised so thank you all for the contributions.

This year my Mayor's Charity is Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust (NMPAT). This charity does a lot of work with children, young adults and also those young children and adults with special educational needs. NMPAT teach them to play musical instruments, learn to sing in choirs or solo and to become young actors giving them an opportunity to put on shows, concerts and perform live in theatres and other venues across the County. I do hope you will all come to events and give as generously as you are able to afford to do. I recently represented Brackley residents by attending a performance by



NMPAT's young adults and children at the Royal and Derngate on 7th July and hope to meet some of you who are going, supporting and attending.

I will be holding a special Mayors' Coffee Morning on 17th September in the Town Hall for Macmillan Cancer Support. I look forward to seeing you there so we can give them a good donation for all the hard work they do looking after local patients and their families.

With best wishes and god bless to all Brackley residents. Let's hope we have a great summer.


