Essential maintenance works update

A43 Brook Culvert Geotechnical scheme

I'm writing to provide an update on our essential maintenance scheme that's currently in construction along the northbound carriageway of the A43.

A43 Brook Culvert Geotechnical scheme – April update

We're making good progress on the A43 northbound between Brackley and Syresham as we work to reinstate a section of the embankment and improve the drainage.

Due to us working within the HS2 weekend closures, we've been able to complete our overnight piling activity approximately 3 weeks ahead of schedule. This now means that we'll be lifting our overnight closure of the northbound A43 carriageway, between Brackley and Syresham, from **1 April** until **21 April 2025**.

We'll then need to reinstate our evening closures of the A43 northbound carriageway from **22 April 2025**, with the closures taking place each evening from **Monday to Friday** between **8pm and 6am**. This will continue through until completion of the scheme in early summer, allowing us to safely complete our remaining earthworks and drainage activities. The escort service from the BP garage at Brackley will be in place throughout this period.
