What's happening, where and when?

<u>Update</u>

We will be utilising the JCB POTHOLE PRO to carry out Essential carriageway works.

Where: Banbury Road, Brackley

When: 3rd- 7th of June

Times: Working hours 09:30am- 14:30pm

How long: 5 shifts

Traffic Management: Road closure - A suitable diversion will be in place. Please do not park on the carriageway during these works. We reserve the right to tow away any vehicles restricting the works.

Residents: Vehicle access will be limited for residents. **Residents with** properties within the road closure will be escorted through by our traffic management contractors.

Emergency Vehicles: We aim to maintain access for emergency vehicles where safe to do so.

Pedestrians and Cyclists: Cyclists will be asked to follow the diversion route. Alternatively, cyclists can dismount their bike and walk on the footway. The footway will be open for pedestrians.

Public Transport: No bus stops will be affected.
