

Roadworks are starting in your area soon.

What's happening, where and when?

What: Carriageway improvements consisting of installing new kerb lines and resurfacing works

Where: Radstone Road, Brackley

When: Monday 20th May 2024 for 4 weeks

Traffic Management: The road between Poppyfields Way and Flanders Way will be closed, and a diversion route will be in place as shown over leaf. The **RED** shows the extent of the closure, and the **BLUE** line shows the diversion routes. The closure times will be 08:00-17:00 weekdays, and outside the closure hours there will be 2- and 3-way temporary traffic signals in place.

Working Hours: 08:00 - 17:00. Monday to Friday

Emergency Vehicles: Will need to follow the signed diversion route while the closure is in place.

Pedestrians and Cyclists: Will be able to access the existing footway and carriageways to get around the works.

Public Transport: There will be no bus service through the closure.

Residents/Bussinesses: Residents of Utah Lane will have access at all times during the works. However the diversion route will need to be followed. Site staff will be happy to assist with any queries. Please allow extra time for your journey during the above dates and times. We endevour to deliver the works with minimal disruption.





Parking and Property/Business Access

We must ask that vehicles are not parked on the road within the works area during the road closure periods. We also recommend you plan extra time for your journeys.

We hope this information is helpful and we apologise for any inconvenience these essential works may cause. We will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary disruption. Our team on site will be ready to assist you with any issues you may have during the work and we hope you will find our employees courteous and helpful.
